



MiriMiri is the offspring of a cross-breeding which possessed promising properties (formative forces according to Dorian Schmidt), in order to launch it as a robust cocktail tomato with a high yield and a balanced taste. After 6 years of selection works we finally present MiriMiri, an outstanding cocktail tomato which meets all our expectations.

In case of an optimal cultivation, MiriMiri is very robust and reliable. It forms strong, indeterminate and narrow plants with airy foliage. It is therefore very well suited for greenhouse cultivation. As a high-yielding variety it brings forward a variety of intensely red, oval to round and small fruits which are bunched together like grapes on the multi-piece and medium-length panicles. The glowing individual fruits can be harvested individually without their calyx. The fruits are burst-resistant for a long time, firmly fleshed but juicy. Its very good shelf life on the panicle and its pressure resistance underline the good marketability of MiriMiri. It can be harvested and commercialized including the panicle but also as a single fruit. Its fruit diameter amounts to about 2 cm and the fruit length to about 3 cm. The average fruit weight is 15-20 g. The decorative, glowing red and crunchy fruits convince with a balanced, sweet aromatic and fruity taste.
